### Notes

- Only the core classes listed above are authorized to give their final exams during the exam week.
- Final exams will be given in classrooms. Each teacher will be given a block of rooms to administer their finals (see page 2).
- Proctoring will be done by teams (i.e. the 9<sup>th</sup> grade team is responsible for proctoring all 9<sup>th</sup> grade exams (see list of teams above)).
- Each day's exam session will be 90 minutes long and will begin at 9.00 am. Students arriving late will not be permitted to enter the classroom to take the exam and will be issued an Incomplete. No Senior may participate in the graduation ceremony with an Incomplete.
- Students **MUST REMAIN IN THE EXAM ROOM** throughout the 90 minute testing session.
- Cell phones are not to be brought into testing rooms.
- Teachers will collect textbooks after the testing session is complete for ALL classes.
- Students are required to leave campus immediately after they are dismissed by the teacher/proctor.
- Students are permitted to remain on campus **ONLY** if they have another scheduled exam or appointment with a teacher, counselor, principal etc.
- The food court, fresco stand, library, computer labs, etc. will be closed to High School (9<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grade) students during exam week.
- Students who are currently enrolled in 2 core classes in a single department (i.e. English 9 & English 10), must make special arrangements with the teacher of the lower level course to take the final exam on the designated exam day, starting after 11.00am.
- No final exams (for the courses listed above) are to be given early.
- All grades must be uploaded by 11am on Friday, May 30<sup>th</sup>.
- Students who are scheduled for three exams on a given exam day (according to the schedule above) should see their counselor ASAP.
- Teachers are authorized to assign a weight 10% of the end-of-year grade to the final exam.
