- Students must have a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher from 9th to 12th grade.
- Students must participate in at least one international academic trip organized by ANS and approved by the Global Studies Coordinator, Mrs. Belinda Lopez.
- Students must take at least six classes from the approved course list below, including a minimum of four of the AP classes listed.
- Students must earn the service cord by completing a minimum of 100 hours of approved community service by the end of 12th grade.
- Students must earn mastery-level completion on the Senior Capstone Project, demonstrating a strong emphasis on global awareness. Students must comply with all Capstone course requirements and any additional requirements as determined by Mrs. Lopez.
